Call for Nominations – Bargaining Committee

Unifor is seeking nominations for members who are interested in stepping forward to work alongside the union to negotiate your first collective agreement.

This is a key role in representing your co-workers and helping shape improvements to wages, benefits, scheduling, and workplace protections.

No prior experience is required. Training and full support will be provided to ensure you are well prepared to participate in the bargaining process.

Members may nominate themselves or a co-worker.

Bargaining Committee Election

The election period for your bargaining committee will:

- Open: 12:00 noon, Wednesday, April 29, 2026
- Close: 12:00 noon, Tuesday, May 5, 2026

Voting will take place by secret electronic ballot.

Members will be asked to select up to two candidates from the list of nominees. The candidate receiving the highest number of votes from the United and Alaska group will serve on the bargaining committee, alongside representatives from Local 4050 and your National Representative.

Full voting details and instructions will be shared prior to the start of voting. Election results will be made available following the close of polls.
